PIREP

Suggested format for a PIREP can be found on the back of the CFS.

1. Location of phenomena in relation to a NAVAID or aerodrome or coordinates and time.
2. Altitude.
3. Aircraft Type.
4. Cloud (Base, Amount, Top).
5. Temperature.
6. Wind direction and speed.
7. Turbulence (Intensity, type, altitude).
8. Icing (Intensity, type, altitude).
9. Remarks.

PIREP

- With smoky conditions you might have an opportunity to file a PIREP.
- As an example, early this spring before the rains came, some PIREPs were filed at Sundre due to smoke.
- Points – 200 pts for filing a PIREP and add an additional 200 pts if you include wind speed and direction. See July Mission regarding wind speed. Get a screen capture of your PIREP for later discussion.
